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

Expand to the East	 Would reduce traffic heading through the town that ultimately heads east to Lys Mill / Henley Would support the development of between 180 – 240 properties Each of the sites is close to the centre of town and the Doctor's surgery 	 Long road to build as an alternative route A minority of traffic heads east after leaving Watlington to the South In AONB/ abuts AONB Highly visible from Watlington Hill Impacts existing residents view of Watlington Hill
Expand to the South	 Would support the development of approximately 150 properties There is existing pedestrian access into the town however it would require upgrading Opens up West Meadow for development as a community amenity 	Long road to build as an alternative route A minority of traffic traverses East to West (and vice versa) through Watlington Although there is pedestrian access the sites are quite isolated from the rest of town Very Pretty Countryside and some parts are in the AONB Abuts Conversation Area Partially in flood plain
