Draft Plan Review

The group reviewed the Draft Plan and documents.

Chapter 6 Policies

Minor changes. TW raised whether the HGV limit will be changed. GB stated that the road is still in the 7.5t limit. There was some discussion on this point.

There was a discussion on Policy 5g – 'Opportunities for small scale local food production'.

Resolved: to keep this in. 3 in favour and 2 against.

Proposals use of CIL to be made a separate chapter.

It was agreed to update the document for Friday 24th March in preparation for the Full Council meeting on the 30th March.
