Localism Act 2011

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Came into force 6th April 2012

- Devolve planning power
- Influence development locations
- Protect valuable assets
- Increase local spending power
- Legal status



Watlington Neighbourhood Plan Area approved by SODC in October 2013 covers the whole parish.





What?

Scope – to be decided by the community, but can cover anything of relevance to the urban planning process

For example the Thame plan includes:

- Development locations
- Housing/Business/Recreation
- Landscape types
- Landscape strategy (conserve/repair/restore)
- Conservation areas
- Flood zones
- Allotments
- Agricultural use
