Green Spaces and Amenity Areas

Watlington has many green spaces which are open to the public, most of which are on the outskirts of the town.

These include:

- Sports fields (cricket, football, bowls, tennis – leased by the Parish Council, or owned by the Watlington Club)
- Parish owned parks and play areas (The Paddock, Mansle Gardens, Recreation Ground, Marlbrook Green)
- Areas open to the public but not publicly owned (Churchyard, West Meadows, Mason's Wood)
- Publicly owned areas not generally open to the public (school playing fields and playgrounds)
 - Parish owned allotments

Of these, only the Icknield College grounds, the allotments and West Meadow offer any potential for housing development, but in the case of the first two would require replacement areas to be found.
